

AlcoholEdu for Bates College Login Directions

To take AlcoholEdu for College, you will need a computer with Internet access and audio capabilities. This course may be taken at a public computer, given that the computer provides internet and is able to play sound. The course may be paused and returned to at any time and at any computer.

To begin AlcoholEdu for College:

1. Go to: Garnet Gateway Entering Students site.
2. Click AlcoholEdu section.
3. Click "Create Account"
4. You may log in and out of the course at the end of each section. Section ends are marked with a "Next" button. *DO NOT log out until you click the "Next" button or you will have to repeat the section you have just gone through.* When you return, you should log back in to the Garnet Gateway.

Should you experience any difficulties or require support, the AlcoholEdu Online Technical Support Center is available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. Simply click on the "Technical Help" button located in the upper right-hand corner of every AlcoholEdu for College screen. You do not need to be logged into the course to access the Technical Support Center.

Deadline Information:

- You may access the course **beginning June 22.**
- You will need to complete **Part 1** (approximately 2.5 hours) **by July 31.** Please note that you need not complete the course in one session; you can save your data and resume the course at a later time. Part 1 ends after the Exam and Survey 2, and you **must earn a grade of 85%** or higher to pass and receive credit for the course. You must complete Part 1 by July 31 in order to access your housing information.
- In the fall after being on campus for about a month (by September 29), you will receive an automated email asking you to complete the course. This email will go to your Bates email if you have changed your AlcoholEdu for College email account settings; if not, it will go to the email address you used in your initial login. At this time, you will need to log in again to complete **Part 2** which takes approximately 15 minutes.
- **NOTE: Only once you have finished Part 2 have you completed the program. The deadline for completion of Part 2 is October 9, 2009.** We ask that you **not start Part 2 prior to September 29.**

Failure to complete the course by stated deadlines will result in a hold on your housing information, which includes information about your room assignment, roommate(s), and email and campus mailbox.

Please note that the course includes three surveys that measure students' alcohol-related attitudes and behaviors. All survey responses are strictly confidential; the school will only receive information about the student body as whole and will never see individual students' answers.
