Naming Bates as a Beneficiary of a Retirement Plan or Other Financial Account

You can name Bates as a beneficiary of a retirement plan (e.g., IRA or pension plan), a life insurance policy, or other financial account not directed by your will or trust.* You may accomplish this by completing and submitting a beneficiary designation change form provided by your retirement plan administrator, insurance company, bank, or brokerage firm. Naming Bates or other charitable organization as a beneficiary may offer significant tax benefits for your estate.

*Certain key assets may not be directed by your will. Please consult with your financial advisor or attorney.

Suggested beneficiary designation form language: "The President and Trustees of Bates College to be used for the general tax-exempt purposes of the college."
