

IMPORTANT INFORMATION REGARDING THE BENNY CARD™ AND YOUR FLEXIBLE SPENDING ACCOUNT

WHAT'S HAPPENING

Easy Access – Better Information – Useful Tools

GDI is updating its software to provide enhanced tools to manage your reimbursement accounts. The following information explains how your Benny Card™ will be impacted for the upcoming plan year.

IMPACT OF CHANGE

NEW FEATURES: Our software platform will provide access to a host of new capabilities and more tools to help you manage your reimbursement account. You will receive more information about these features upon enrollment in a Medical or Dependent Care FSA for the upcoming plan year.

BENNY CARD™: Your current Benny Card™ will be deactivated at the close of business on December 31. To avoid confusion we suggest that you destroy the card when the new plan year begins January 1.



GDI DEBIT CARD: If you choose to have a debit card for the Medical FSA plan year beginning January 1, you will receive a “GDI debit card”. The new card will arrive at your home address in a **plain white window-style envelope**. This card can only be used for expenses incurred on or after January 1, 2012.

GRACE PERIOD: If possible, spend down your current account balance before your plan year ends on December 31! If you are unable to exhaust your account balance prior to the end of the December, you may submit paper claims during the Grace Period. A Reimbursement Request form is available on our website, www.gdynamic.com.

KEY DATES:

December 31: Your current plan year ends and your Benny Card™ will be deactivated.

January 1: The new plan year begins. Your new GDI debit card will access funds you elected to set aside for this plan year.

GRACE PERIOD:

If you haven't exhausted your remaining FSA funds from the plan year ending December 31, you may spend down the account and submit paper claims.

RUN-OUT PERIOD: This is the deadline to submit receipts for services incurred January 1, 2011 through the end of your grace period.
