Reserve materials at Ladd are frequently in high demand. **There are short loan periods in place to allow access for all students in the class.** Please make note of the due time for each item checked out. Items returned late are fined at \$2.00 per hour. The fine increases to \$4.00 per hour after four hours overdue. These fines are in place to ensure fair access for all students in the class.

- **Circulation Desk Reserves** may have a **two hour, 24 hour, or three day loan period.** Most print materials may be taken from the library.
- **Audio Desk Reserves** all have a **four hour** loan period. A/V materials may not be removed from the library, except by the professor who has placed the reserve. There are facilities within the Audio/ Video Area to view and listen to these reserves.
