In addition, we have a Civic Engagement and Public Values requirement. This is a Community-based Learning Experience where students integrate coursework to a community need and reflect upon it, while considering their roles as educated citizen in a democracy. These courses include: Web-Design for Non-Profit Organizations, The Road to the White House, Women, Communication & the United Nations, Developing a Historic Heritage Center in Lower Manhattan, Service and Study in Latin America, Children in Urban Society, and the 9/11 Oral History Project.
