Successful applicants must submit a brief report halfway through their summer and a final report on their summer work to the Center by September 1, 2007. The site director must also agree to submit a brief report on your work by September 1, 2007. Recipients of a Harward Student Service Fellowship are also expected to prepare a presentation to share with the College community during the ensuring year.
