Courses Taken Abroad. A student may petition to have up to three comparable courses, completed at other institutions in either the United States or abroad, applied toward the minor.

Advanced Placement courses may not be applied toward the minor.

Pass/Fail Grading Option. Pass/fail grading may not be elected for courses applied toward the Chinese minor.

Restrictions on double-dipping. Majors and minors in Chinese may count no more than one course toward both the Asian Studies minor and their major.
