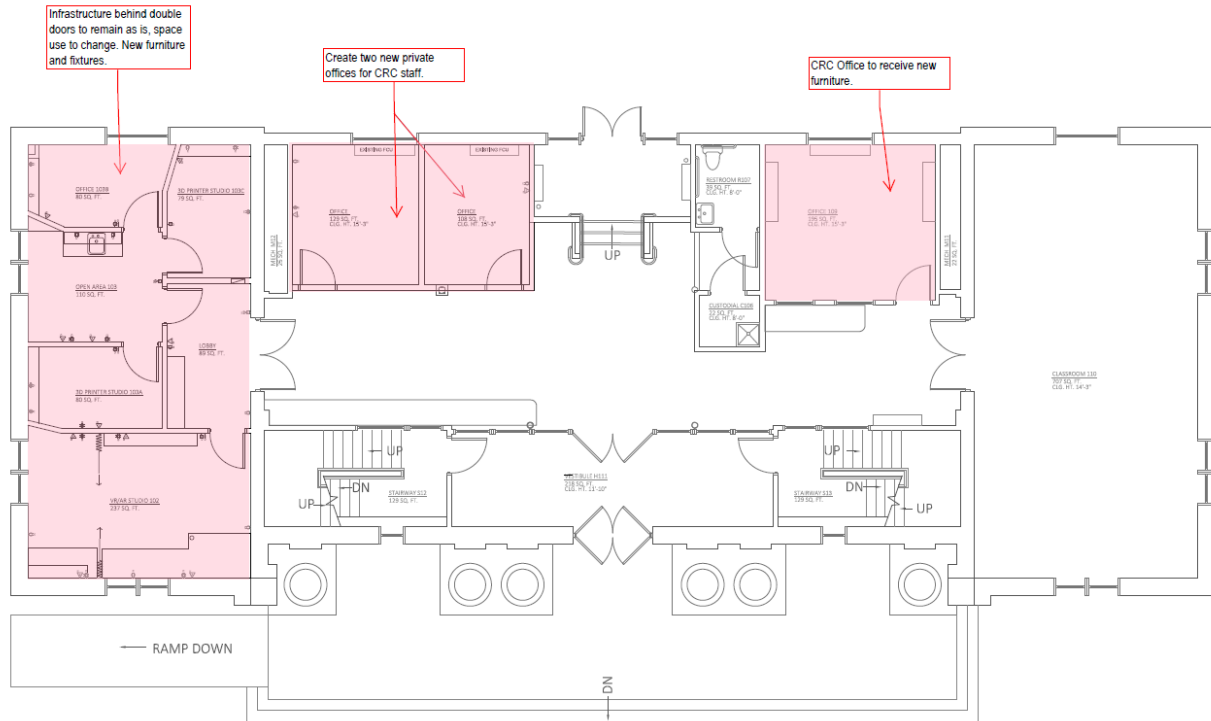


CORAM ILS RENOVATION (CURRICULAR AND RESEARCH COMPUTING)

(Renovation)

PROGRAMMATIC DRIVER: Curricular and Research Computing (CRC) staff were displaced from two offices within Pettengill when Digital and Computational Studies (DCS) moved in. The CRC staff backfilled the vacated Imaging Suite on the first floor of Coram, however, the space in its current configuration is not conducive as offices and does not meet the growing program's needs.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: CRC has requested the following program:

- (4) Offices
- (1) Virtual Reality (VR)/Augmented Reality (AR) Studio
- (1) Small rooms to house 3D printers

In order to achieve this program, the existing infrastructure of the Imaging Suite will essential remain as is. Two of the three small rooms will house multiple 3D printers, the one small room with a window will be occupied by the CRC Staff that oversees the 3D printers, and Room 102 will become the VR/AR Studio. Room 109 will continue to be used as a CRC office, and two new offices will be created in what is currently the underutilized open lounge area.
