- Detailed explanation, including effective date of unemployment/change in income
- 2023 federal tax return including schedules and W-2 forms
- Separation/termination letter from employer
- Copy of severance benefits, if applicable
- Copy of unemployment benefits statement, if applicable
- Most recent paycheck stub(s) from each parent

# Death or disability of a parent:

• Letter with relevant supporting documentation

# Loss of untaxed income (social security, pension, child support, etc.)

• Detailed explanation, with relevant supporting documentation

# High medical/dental expenses paid by the family

- Detailed explanation
