

MAINTAIN SOCIAL DISTANCING

ALL members of the public must stay at least **6 feet apart at all times in the courthouse. This includes hallways and courtrooms.**

No more than **TEN PEOPLE will be allowed into the courtroom at any one time.**

Maximum Occupancy Guidelines will be enforced.

During this public health emergency, we pledge to do all we can to keep our employees and the public who come to our courthouses healthy and safe.

Therefore, please **DO NOT** enter a courthouse if you:

- Have traveled from an area with widespread COVID-19 contagion within the last 14 days;
- Reside or have had close contact with someone who has traveled from an area with widespread COVID-19 contagions within the last 14 days; or
- Have been asked to self-quarantine by any hospital or health agency; or
- Have been diagnosed with, or have had contact with, anyone who has been diagnosed with COVID-19; or
- You are experiencing any acute respiratory illness symptoms (i.e. cough, shortness of breath), flu-like symptoms, have a fever, or are coughing or sneezing.
