Are you being evicted or at risk of being evicted?

- Your landlord cannot make you leave your unit without a court order.
- There are many rules your landlord must follow before you can be removed from your home. Your landlord cannot evict you if a judge finds they do not follow all of the rules.
- Due to COVID-19, there are extra things <u>some</u> landlords must do before they can evict their tenants.
- There are financial assistance programs that may be able to help you pay your rent!
- Maine courts are starting to set court dates for eviction cases. The first court date will usually be held by phone. You have the right to ask for an in-person hearing to have the judge hear your case.

Pine Tree Legal Assistance may be able to help you if you are at risk of losing your rental unit.

Pine Tree Legal Assistance will never contact your landlord without your permission.
