COST OF PLAN SERVICES

There are three categories of services provided to your plan:

1. GENERAL ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICES

General administrative services include recordkeeping, legal, accounting, consulting, investment advisory and other plan administration services. Some of the expenses for general administrative services are fixed and other expenses such as legal or accounting may vary from year to year. These costs are allocated to each participant in a uniform way.

In addition to investment expenses you pay, there is a Plan Servicing Fee charged to specific investments which is used to pay for your Plan's record keeping and other plan services. Also, your Plan provides credits to certain investments so that plan participants share equally in the cost of such expenses.
