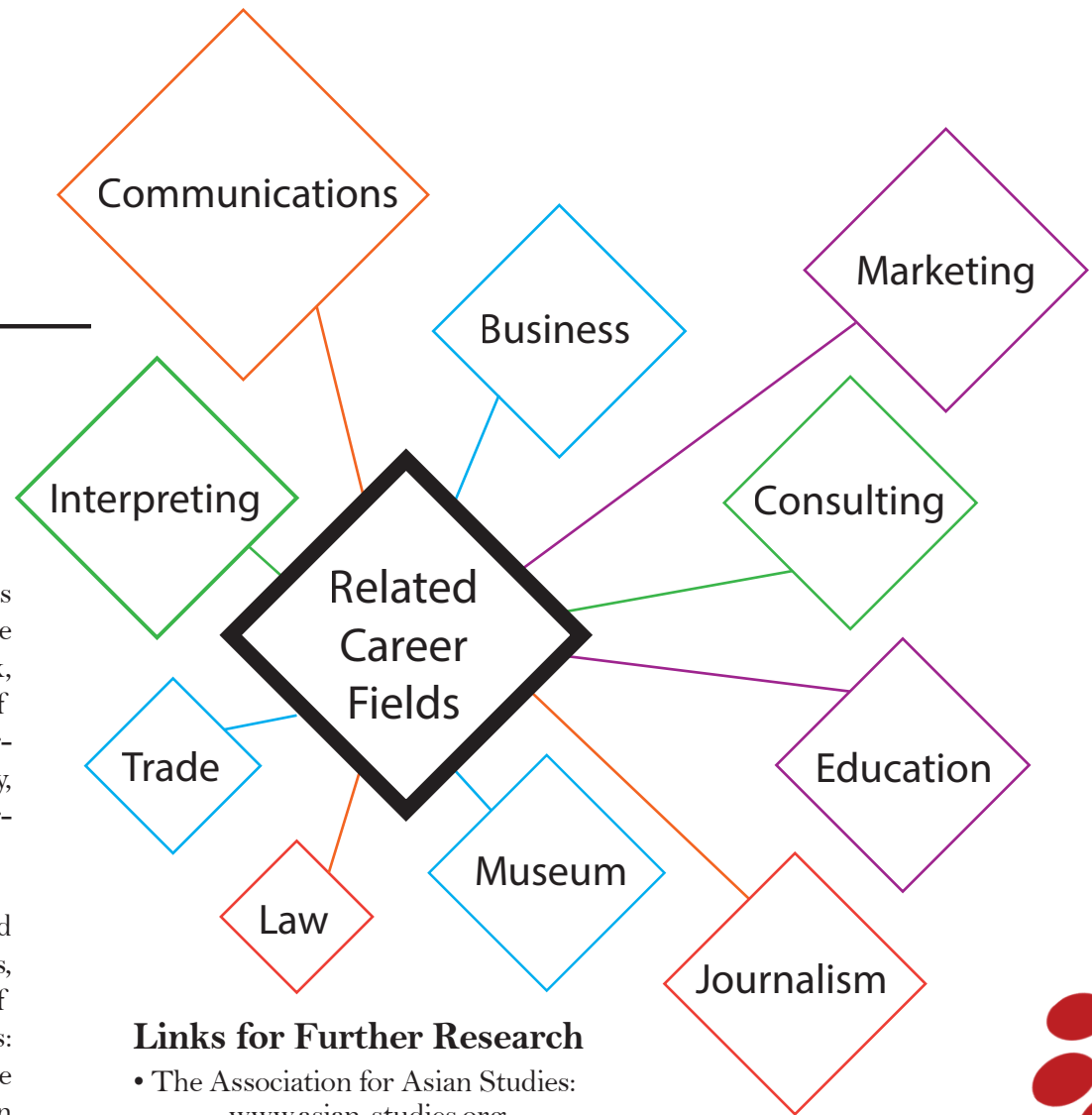
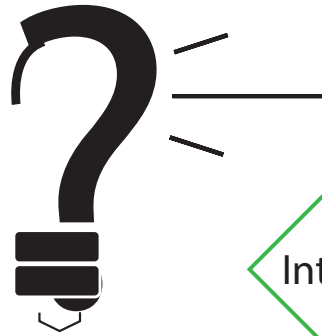


ASIAN STUDIES WHAT CAN I DO WITH MY MAJOR



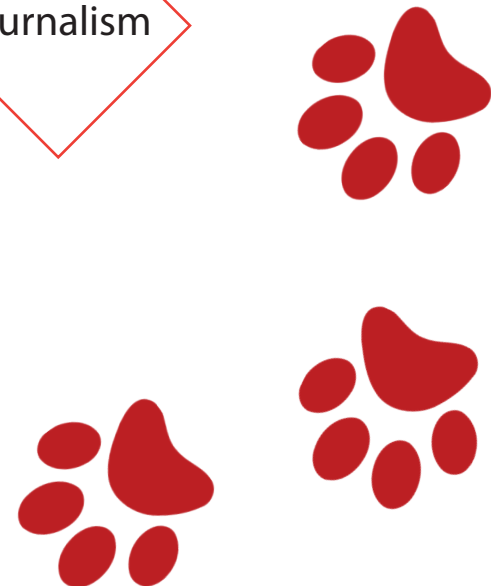

In addition to the majors, the Program in Asian Studies offers minors in Chinese, Japanese, and Asian studies.
