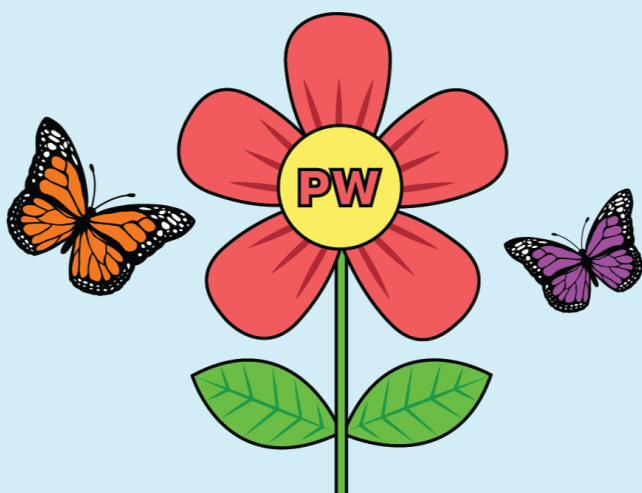

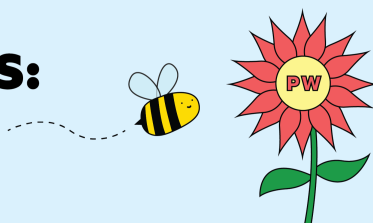


Fake job listings and phony interviews are becoming increasingly common!

Be cautious of roles that promise high pay for minimal work, request for payments upfront, or use personal email addresses for communication. Legitimate employers will never ask you to pay for training, equipment, or to apply. Always research the company and trust your instincts and if something feels off, it probably is.
