# **Animal Bite Response- Standard Operating Procedure**

**In the event of a medical emergency,** call 207-786-6111 to reach Bates Campus Safety, or 911. Officers will respond and supporting agencies (EMS, fire department, etc.) will be notified, as needed.

If it is not a medical emergency, please follow the procedure listed below:

## **Immediately After the Bite:**

- 1. After receiving an animal bite, secure the animal (if safely possible) in their cage/holding area.
- 2. Evaluate the bite- check to see if the bite broke the skin, or if there is any bleeding.
- 3. Provide first aid- there is a first aid kit in the Vivarium hallway, to the immediate right of the entryway door from the ante room. Clean the bite wound and provide a topical antibiotic and band aid.
- 4. If medical assistance is needed, contact Jim Morrison (see contact information below).

#### **After Medical Care is Provided:**

- 1. Report the injury to your supervisor. They will complete an <u>Injury/Incident Report</u>, with your assistance/information.
- 2. This completed form should be submitted to Jim Morrison (Director of Environmental, Health & Safety) by email, or to <a href="mailto:benefits@bate.edu">benefits@bate.edu</a>. It is also acceptable to handwrite/deliver this form to HR office at 215 College Street.
- 3. This form should also be submitted to Jessi Kemp (Vivarium Coordinator) to keep in the animal colony records.
- 4. After the injury has been reported, the Environmental Health and Safety Department will communicate with the affected employee regarding an injury investigation, if necessary.
